YEAR 2 NATIVITY

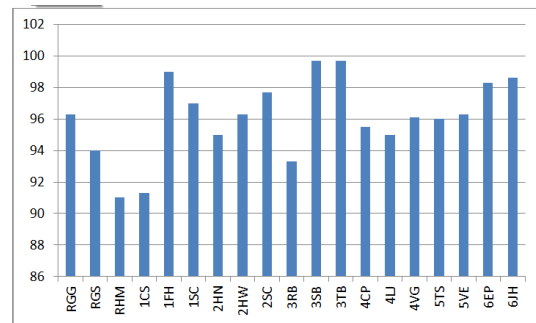
Our Year 2 Nativity will be on **Thursday 13th December** (2:00pm) and **Friday 14th December** (9:30am). All parents/carers welcome.
