Mr Thompson has been appointed as Head of School and will lead the school when Mrs Blay is on Ofsted duties.


EXTRA CURRICULAR CLUBS

Please ask at the school office if you do not have your log-in details. If this method presents you with difficulty then cash can be accepted at the school office. Thank you.
