CORONAVIRUS SYMPTOMS

Please do not bring you child into school if they have any Coronavirus symptoms. The main symptoms of Coronavirus in children are:

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot for more than an hour or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- a loss or change to sense of smell or taste this means they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.

If your child has any of the main symptoms of Coronavirus please get a test as soon as possible. You can arrange this by calling 119.

If a child develops symptoms throughout the day, their parents will be contacted and the child will be sent home. A text message will be sent to the parents of the children in the class to inform them that a child has developed symptoms. The Government guidance is that children should continue to attend school and if the child tests positive for Covid 19, the school will contact you to take the next steps.

ARRIVAL/PICK-UP TIMES
