
## WELCOME BACK

## CORONAVIRUS SYMPTOMS

Pupils **MUST NOT** attend school if they or anyone in their household displays any Coronavirus symptoms. The main symptoms for Coronavirus are:

- A new or continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- A high temperature
- A loss of or change to sense of smell or taste – this means they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.



If you or your child has any of the main symptoms please get a test as soon as possible. You can arrange this by calling 119.
