Children over the age of five. If you would like your child to have milk in September, please register online at www.coolmilk.com. If you need help registering, please contact Cool milk on 0800 321 3248. The cost of milk is currently 28p per day. **Children Entitled to Benefit related Free School Meal.** Children entitled to a Benefit Related Free School Meal, are now entitled to Free School Milk. If you would like your child to have free school milk in September, please inform the school office by Monday morning.

SCHOOL MEALS

As you are aware, all children in Reception, Yr1 and Yr2 classes are entitled to a **Universal Free School Meal**. If your child is currently bringing a packed lunch and you would like them to have a Universal Free School Dinner in September, please inform the school office.

Children going into Nursery, Yr3, Yr4, Yr5 and Yr6 will need to pay for their school meal as usual unless they are entitled to a **Benefit Related Free School Meal**. The cost of a school meal at present is £12.50 per week payable on a Monday morning. **Please inform the school office if you would like to change your child's meal arrangements for Sept 2024.**

REMINDER DINNER MONEY

As it is the end of term next Friday, we ask that all dinner money is paid up to date by Monday morning. You can make payment using our online payment system School Gateway. Alternatively, you can make payments using cash or card at the school office.
