

Literacy

Pupils will learn about:

- Recognising their own name.
- Making marks with pencils and pens.
- Writing their own name.
- Matching letter shapes in their name.
- Words that rhyme.
- Listening and identifying different sounds in the environment.

Texts

- Peace at last
- Guess how much I love you
- You Choose!
- Five Minutes Peace

Mathematics

Pupils will learn about:

- Ordering the events in the day.
- Using shapes to make a house picture.
- Counting rhymes; 5 little monkeys, 5 currant buns, 5 speckled frogs, 1,2,3,4,5.
- Sorting and categorising objects.
- Counting by rote accurately.
- Giving 1 or 2 objects on request.
- Talking about difference in quantities.

Physical Development

Pupils will learn about:

- Using equipment inside the classroom and outside safely.
- The importance of hygiene and washing hands.
- Putting their coats on independently.
- The food they eat; healthy and unhealthy.
- Forming lines and shapes using pencils, flour, foam, dough.
- Throwing, catching, kicking balls

Expressive Arts and Design

Pupils will learn about:

- Role play- Home corner and Hairdressers
- Drawing and painting a self portrait
- Drawing a picture of my family
- Using colours appropriately
- Singing favourite songs and rhymes
- How to fix construction equipment together to build for a purpose
- Learning how to print with different body parts.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Pupils will learn about:

- The routines and rules in Nursery.
- Taking turns, playing games.
- How we tidy up at Nursery. we look after our toys? Why?
- New friends – their names.
- How to use the resources in Nursery.
- What makes them: sad, happy, cross, scared and worried.
- Good hygiene
- Different families
- Body parts

Understanding the World

Pupils will learn about:

- The Nursery classroom and the outdoor environment
- Their family and different families
- Their five senses, exploring why we need them
- Body parts and what they do
- Autumn is here – what is Autumn?
- Investigating cause and effect equipment
- Mirrors and what they can see in them.

Communication and Language Development

Pupils will learn about:

- Words to describe themselves and their physical appearance (tall, short, etc)
- Talk about their likes and dislikes (food, toys, colours, places to visit, etc)
- Talking about their family and home
- Talking about their favourite place to play in Nursery
- Singing new Nursery Rhymes
- Imagining and creating roles in real life situations (home corner, hairdressers)
- Talking to new children and making friends.
