

## Physical Development

### *Pupils will be taught to:*

- Observe the effect of activity on their bodies, negotiating space, adjusting speed and direction.
- Move in a range of ways, slithering, shuffling, rolling, crawling, skipping, sliding.
- Whats the time Mr Wolf and circle games – links to 3 Little Pigs.
- Use simple tools to effect changes in materials.
- Develop their co ordination and control - Making bridges with different materials for the Billy Goats Gruff.
- Explore a range of healthy foods. What do the 3

## Mathematics

### *Pupils will be taught to:*

- Order and recognise numbers - Little Pigs front doors
- Order by size, sort objects by size, use the language of size – 3 Bears
- Count out specific amounts and match to the correct numeral – 3 Bears
- Investigate 2D and 3D shapes- making Goats and Trolls
- Ordering items by height – Bears, pigs, houses.
- Weigh ingredients talk about more and less – baking Gingerbread Men

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

### *Pupils will be taught to:*

- Understand that their actions affect other people.
- Encourage other children to join in their play and to listen to other peoples ideas.
- Think about how we make friends and show friendly behaviour, the importance of responding to other people.
- Talk about their own interests and opinions.
- How to help if someone is upset.

## Expressive Arts and Design

### *Pupils will be taught to:*

- Make representations of different characters.
- Move to music in different ways; fast, slow, heavy, light.
- Use movement to express feelings, link to texts.
- Re enact stories using available props.
- Make your own troll – what do you think he looks like?
- Explore colours and how they can be changed.
- Design and make a Mothers Day card
- Easter activities and cards

# Once Upon A Time Nursery-Spring 2

## Understanding the World

### *Pupils will be taught to:*

- Recognise and describe special times for family – Shrove Tuesday, Mothers Day
- Comment and ask questions about aspects of their familiar world – use the forest area to build houses from sticks, builder to come in and build a brick wall.
- Talk about why things happen and how things work – Link to building houses, making porridge, baking Gingerbread men.
- Construct for a purpose, linking to The 3 Billy Goats Gruff.
- Record voice messages.

## Literacy Development

### *Pupils will be taught to:*

- Retell the traditional tales (refer to texts).
- Describe the main story settings, events and principal characters.
- Recognise familiar words and signs.
- Continue a rhyming string.
- Write labels and speech bubbles relating to the texts.
- Write for a purpose - writing letters to the Wolf and the Troll.

## Communication & Language Development

### *Pupils will be taught to:*

- Join in with repeated refrains in stories.
- Act out their own puppet shows showing their recall of stories.
- Use intonation and tone as they retell stories, taking on the role of characters.
- Develop their understanding of the use of different objects.
- Follow instructions without support.
- Ask questions using who, what, when how
